## YOUTH AND FAMILY PROGRAMS

MHP offers educational programs for residents to develop skills, expand their opportunities, and balance their lives. This includes preschool, afterschool, and summer enrichment programs serving more than 450 children.

MHP's Community Life enrichment program was launched in 1998, and currently serves children and their families at community centers at rental properties owned by MHP in Silver Spring, Wheaton, Rockville, and Takoma Park.

MHP partners with local organizations to provide services and resources to children and their parents. We also run annual backpack and holiday gift drives for our residents.
